

HEARTS 'N STARS TILE TRAY

SUPPLIES:

6 - 6inch square bisque tiles
CN 311 LIGHT GINGER
CN282 BRIGHT BROWN
CN073 DARK SCARLET
CN253 BLACK
CN232 BRIGHT BRIARWOOD
Clear food safe glaze
Sponge
Card Stock-to use as stencil
#1 liner



TECHNIQUE:

Make reverse stencils. Any shape hearts and stars that you desire, or use pattern on attached page.

Wipe tiles with damp sponge.

Using ginger sponge color around outside edge of tile going. I sponged nearly 1/3 of the tile-fading towards the center. Let Dry.

Using stencil, sponge in dark scarlet hearts and stars as desired. Apply 2 coats before lifting stencil. Centers can be faded or as you desire. Let Dry.

Using bright brown and liner brush make scrolls all the way around the tile. Work from the edge of the hearts and stars connecting them together. These are much lighter than the next brown we will be using. Do the same with bright briarwood-remember this is a much stronger brown. There can be many or just a few.

Add berries and branches. Branches are briarwood with a little black mix in. Berries are made by tipping brush handle in black then in in the briarwood-they can even have some dark scarlet in them too.

Splatter as desired with briarwood. Remember to thin color and practice before applying to tiles.

Dry thoroughly and apply food safe clear glaze as per manufacturers' direction.

Fire to cone 05-06 and ENJOY!
