

PINK FLAMINGO STANDING RULES – UPDATED MARCH 25, 2017

1. Meeting dates are scheduled by the Board yearly. Members are notified in advance no later than 30 days prior to the first meeting of the new year. Meetings are normally scheduled in the months of February, April, June, August, October and December, and every effort is made to alternate Saturdays and Sundays to accommodate members who attend church on Sunday
2. Chapter membership dues are \$15.00 per year.
3. The Officers on the Board or any chapter members shall be reimbursed for any expenses incurred on behalf of Pink Flamingos upon completion of check request form (with receipts) and authorization from the President or Treasurer. Any expenses over \$50.00 must have plurality of board or members for approval. 2-27-2011
4. Philanthropic Fund established with beginning balance of \$388.25 from the 2010 regional's silent auction profit. 2-27-2011, Philanthropic Fund dissolved due to depleted funds 1-28-2017
5. Pink Flamingo website established-February 2011. ENewsletter established-July 2012.
6. The Chapter will sponsor classes after every Chapter meeting;
 - a. A. Duncan U -\$25.00/ Member pays \$15.00 and PF Chapter subsidizing \$10.00 for chapter member in good standing - total of \$25.00 to be paid to Duncan Ambassador.
 - b. Class (other than Duncan U) - \$10.00/Member pays \$10.00. The \$10.00 proceeds are divided-\$3.00 is retained by the PF Chapter and \$7.00 balance is paid to the instructor.
7. Please note that these class fees DO NOT include ware AND chapter members agreed to try to "pool" the paint needed for each class to keep costs as economical as possible. 2-27-2011.
8. Chapter members will be reminded about chapter meetings/events a week prior to the event (most likely via email broadcast). 4-29-2011
9. Bereavement Fund: The chapter will send a \$75.00 condolence stipend to member/members' family in case of members or immediate family members' death. This expense is exempt from prior approval from Board/members. 2/27/2011 Immediate family defined as: husband, wife, offspring, and parents of member 1-28-2017
10. Checks will be signed by the Treasurer or President. A completed check request form, will include all relevant receipts attached and will be approved by Treasurer or President before reimbursement/payment. 3-25-2017
11. One class certificate with a value of \$35.00 will be given out to a member in attendance at each meeting, once a member "wins" they are not eligible again for 12 months; and have 12 months to perform a show and tell on a completed project at a meeting to receive \$35.00. 6-28-2013
12. Chapter meeting host/hostess will be reimbursed \$50.00 for use of facility. 1-28-2017
13. Guests at Chapter Meetings; any ceramist, CDT or a currently enrolled student in the Duncan Certification program will be allowed to attend 2 Chapter meets as a Guest prior to joining Chapter. Guest/s will pay full price for any education offered. 3-25-2017
